**Girl Guide Cookies** were first baked by a Regina Guide Leader, Christina Riepsamen\* in 1927. They were sold door-to-door for 10 cents a bag of 12 cookies as a means to earn passenger rail fares for a camping trip to a lake\*. The sales were brisk, requiring extra batches to be baked to meet demand. It was then adopted as a simple way to raise money for uniforms and camping equipment.

In 1929, the National Headquarters began selling the cookies across Canada. *Wikipedia*

- \* Christina Riepsamen was the mother of Henny Proctor who was married to Rev. Basil Proctor, Priest at St. Matthew's from 1957 - 1969.
- \* The lake that they were likely going to by rail would be Regina Beach.
